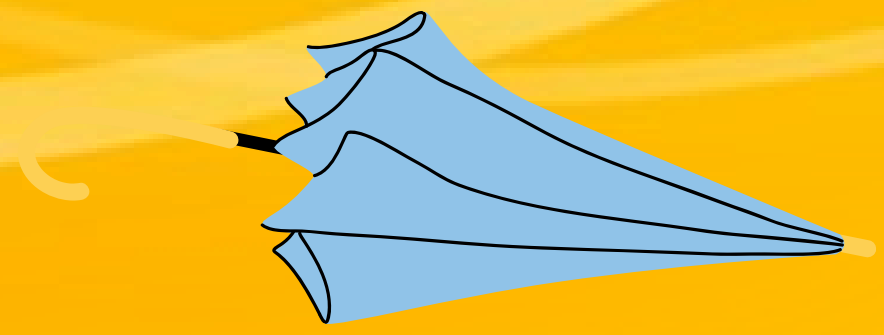
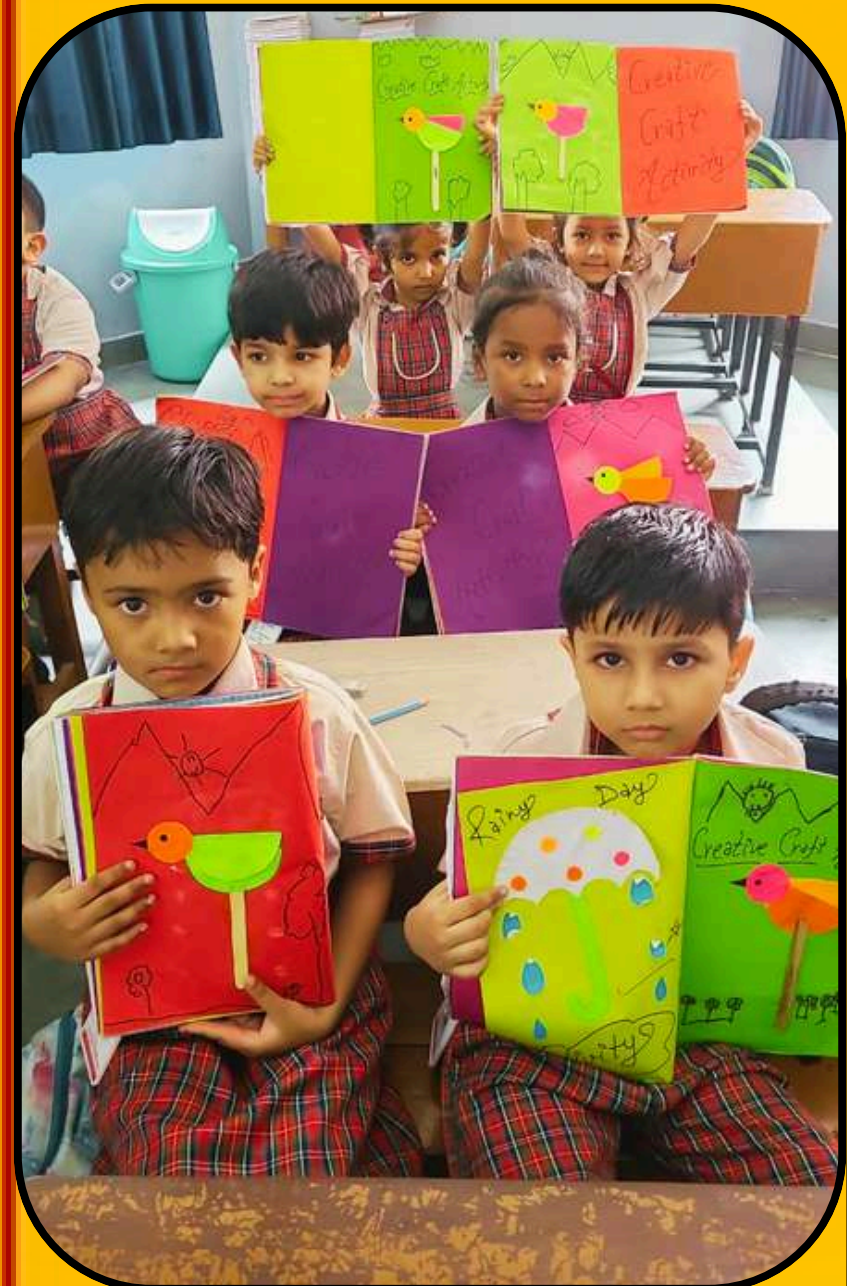




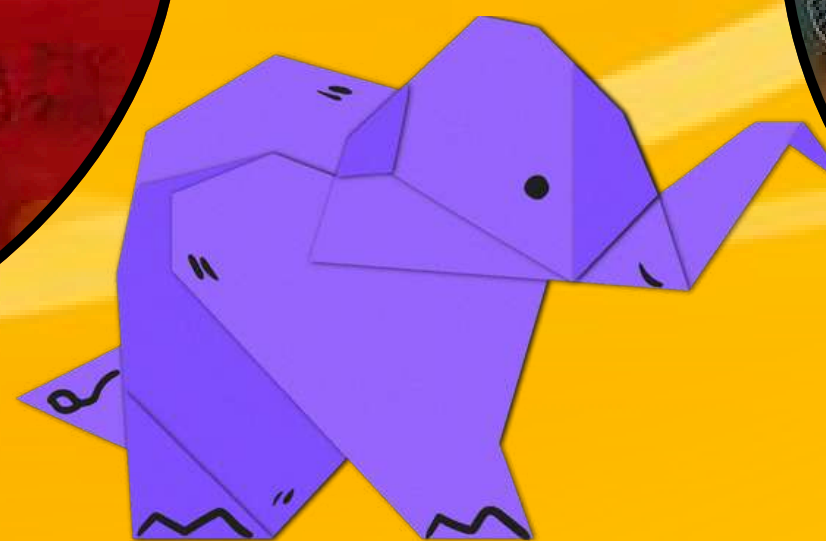
Craft work is a very creative activity for children to enhance the cognitive skills

Children enjoyed the activity a lot and learnt the use of fevicol, cutting & folding.



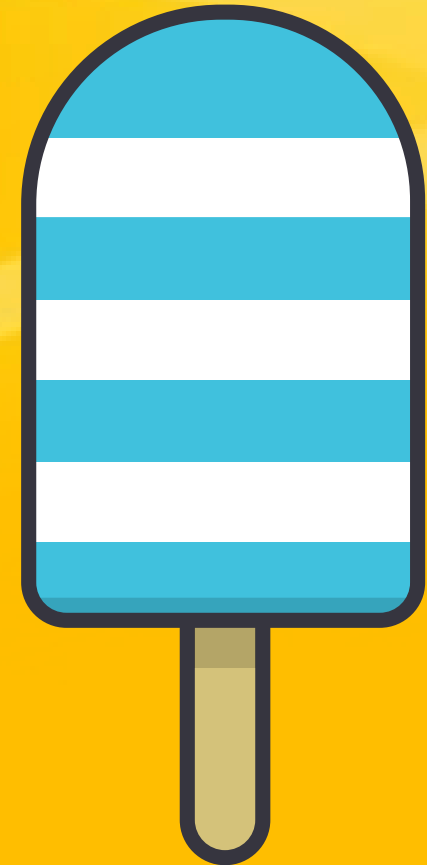
